The Chrism Mass is the commemoration of the institution of the priesthood. Traditionally held on Holy Thursday morning at the diocese's cathedral church. What happens during the Chrism Mass?

- The local bishop blesses the chrism and other holv oils, and distributes them to parishes to be used over the next year.
- Priests in the diocese gather in solidarity with their local bishop and renew their commitment to priestly service.
- The congregation prays for those who serve the Church.
- The bishop blesses three vessels of oils:
 - Chrism for baptisms & confirmations
 - $\dot{\mathbf{v}}$ Second Oil – for catechumens
 - Third Oil for anointing the sick
