The Holy Family REFLECTION FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Every Sunday after the Christmas celebration, we are celebrating the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. This Holy family is the model of Christian families. Pope Pius XII said something about the family, "The life of a family united in intimate love is so beautiful!
