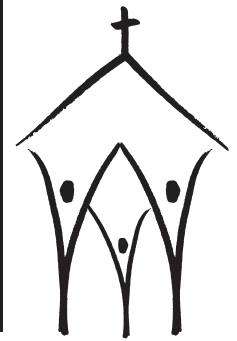

Christ the King Sunday

REFLECTIONS

Readings:
2 Samuel 5:1-3
Colossians 1:12-20
Luke 23:35-43



Today as a Church, we conclude our liturgical year and celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. The Gospel we proclaim shows the great mystery of our faith: In the moment of his crucifixion, Jesus is shown to be King and Savior of all.

Luke's Gospel has been loaded with surprises: the poor are rich, sinners find salvation, the Kingdom of God is found in our midst. Here we see the greatest surprise of all. We are confronted with the crucified Jesus, whom faith tells us is King and Savior of all. The irony is that the inscription placed on the cross, perhaps in mockery, contains the profoundest of truth. As the leaders jeer, the thief crucified by his side recognizes Jesus as Messiah and King, and finds salvation.

Jesus is King, but not the kind of king we might have imagined or expected. His kingship was hidden from many of his contemporaries, but those who had the eyes of faith were able to see. As modern disciples of Jesus, we, too, struggle at times to recognize Jesus as King. Today's Gospel invites us to make our own judgment. With eyes of faith, we, too, recognize that Jesus, the crucified One, is indeed King and Savior of all.

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL APPEAL FOR ANNUAL COLLECTION NOV 26 & 27



Envelopes for the Saint Vincent de Paul Society collection are in your boxes and are also being distributed this week.

With the funds we receive from your donations we act on behalf of St. Dominic's Parish community. The money collected is used all year by the Society. We are quite remarkable in that 100% of the donations are given away. No expenses or honorariums are deducted by the Society, we do not take mileage. We make visits and give vouchers for the grocery stores to our neighbours-in-need.

So far this year we have made approximately 340 visits, issued about 300 grocery vouchers totalling \$15,000.00, and 341 bus tickets. We helped 275 children, and 576 adults. We are able to order beds, and kitchen tables and chairs and helped people in a limited way with rent arrears. As a Society in this Parish we have provided over 500 volunteer hours in outreach.

So please donate generously next week. It allows us to reach out for you and from you.

We are also in need of new members. If you are interested in serving your community please leave your name on extension 6 of the church phone line, or leave your name in the office. We meet once a month. Thank you for your support.

UKRAINIAN CRISIS UPDATE

Are you able to host a Ukrainian family?

When hearing reports of the war in Ukraine, and the millions of Ukrainians that have been forced to flee their homeland, many have asked what they can do to help. Over 80,000 Ukrainians have already arrived to Canada through a special visa program created by Immigration Canada. An additional 500,000 have applied to the program and are expected to arrive in the coming months. Many are arriving to Toronto and are without family here in Canada to help them. Among those will be some who are vulnerable to human trafficking, particularly seniors, single women, and women with children. There is an immediate need for families to host for a period of between one and six months some of those who have arrived. 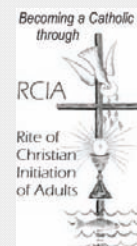
