Solemnity of Mary REFLECTIONS Readings:

Numbers 6.22-27 Galatians 4.4-7 Luke 2.16-21

Today is a day of blessing. In this New Year, God has blessed us with another opportunity to grow in love, to come closer to Him, and to experience Him in the person of Jesus. Today is a day of blessing. We honour Mary – she who was blessed among women – as the mother of God. "When the appointed time came, God sent his Son, born of a woman..." (Gal 4:4).

It is God who blesses his creation. God blesses human beings. Mary is blessed among all women because God chose her to be the mother of His Son. A singular grace granted to a human being. So the blessing of God represents the grace that He showers on us out of His provident love. Today, as we stand at the threshold of this New Year, we stand in need of His blessing. Parents/guardians can register online at <u>dpcdsb.org</u>.

Registration is open to Catholic children and children of Catholic parents. Kindergarten students must be at least four (4) years of age by December 31, 2023.

The following documents are required to complete the registration process:

- Proof of age of the child
- Original Roman Catholic baptismal certificate (for child and/or parent/guardian) or original baptismal certificate from a church in full communion with the Holy See of Rome or an Eastern Catholic Church.
- Immunization Reference #'s from the local Public Health Unit
- Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status
- Proof of home address
- Proof of English Separate School Support


