# Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

REFLECTIONS

Readings: Ezekiel 33:7-9 Romans 13:8-10 Matthew 18:15-20

There is a valuable message in what Jesus says in the Gospel today... *"If your brother does something wrong, go and have it out with him alone, between your two selves."* Jesus wants issues resolved in a way that both parties respect preserve the dignity of each other.

He goes on... "If he does not listen, take one or two others along with you: the evidence of two or three witnesses is required to sustain any charge." The voice of two or three may bring more weight and help the parties to realize that there is a better way forward. But again, there must be respect and concern. Finally, Jesus tells us... "If he refuses to listen to the community, treat him like a pagan or a tax collector."

Harsh!!! Yes, but treating the brother [or a sister] as an outcast may help him see the error of his ways and bring about conversion, much like the Prodigal Son came to his senses and sought forgiveness when he realized the wrong he had chosen. What is often called 'tough love' with regard to people who have an addiction and their family have to let them go to the bottom before they can begin to get up and begin the road to recovery!

While alone with our brokenness, Gods' light can shine and enable us to hear the voice of the Holy Spirit saying, "Come back to me even in your brokenness, and I will make you whole." In treating with others, we must see them as sisters and brothers, children of God like each of us, and, just like each of us, needing direction in our life's journey.

# Sept 09<sup>th</sup> – Sept 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023 NEW FUNDING CAMPAIGNS

We have two new funding campaigns and we distributed pledge cards for parishioners to complete. Please return the pledge cards to the parish office or place it in the collection basket or in the donation boxes at the front of the church. Also please remember to record your envelope number and your name on the pledge card for better tracking.



The first campaign is the capital campaign for items

such as upgrading the parking lot, the furnace and the parish sound system and lighting. Our parish was built in 1957 and some of the items are way overdue for upgrades as the church is almost 70 years old. The parking lot has been cited by the Archdiocese as a potential safety hazard.

The second campaign is a loan repayment initiative. As presented in the 2021 financial statements there are outstanding loans payable to the Archdiocese of \$581,000. The Archdiocese has graciously allowed a matching program for our loan repayment campaign and a dollar for dollar match up to \$200,000. That means if we raise \$200,000, the Archdiocese will match that \$200,000 for a total repayment of \$400,000.

The proceeds of these two campaigns will go directly to supporting St. Dominic's. With the Family of Faith campaign that was started in 2015, only 25% of the amounts went towards St. Dominic's and the remainder went to the Archdiocese. We are hoping parishioners would contribute to these campaigns in the same capacity as they donated to the Family of Faith campaign.

Envelopes for the two campaigns and pledge cards are available at the entrances of the church and we have the ability to take online donations for each of the campaigns if you visit the St. Dominic's website (https://stdominicsmi.archtoronto.org).

Working together we can make these two campaigns a success.
