Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time REFLECTIONS

Readings: Ecclesiasticus 27:30-28:1-7

Romans 14:7-9 Mathew 18: 21-35

This contains the story of a man who was very good at begging mercy for himself but was very poor at extending mercy to others. Each one of us needs to be forgiven by God but the Gospel tells us that if God is to forgive us then we have to forgive others. None of us can say that he or she has never been hurt by anybody or has never hurt anyone so apart from receiving forgiveness from God we need to forgive others and we need to ask forgiveness from the people we have hurt. If we don't forgive, we lose the capacity to love.

We need to learn to let go of those things that cause hatred and bitterness in our hearts. As we clean our houses, wash our clothes and utensils we need to do the same in our hearts and minds. The way to destroy enemies is by forgiving them. Once you forgive them then you no longer have enemies.

My dear brother and sisters to forgive we need a humble spirit. Once we have forgiven others then God will forgive us also and once God forgives us we become free from the burden of bitterness, revenge, and retaliation. Life is short. For those who are strong, the Psalmist gives the life span of 80years and for the weak 70years. Why should we spend a little time with bitterness and grudges? Let us forgive now, let us forgive today for we are not in charge of tomorrow.

Sept 16th – Sept 23rd, 2023 NEW FUNDING CAMPAIGNS

We have two new funding campaigns and we distributed pledge cards for parishioners to complete. Please return the pledge cards to the parish office or place it in the collection basket or in the donation boxes at the front of the church. Also please remember to record your envelope number and your name on the pledge card for better tracking.



The first campaign is the capital campaign for items such as upgrading the parking lot, the furnace and the parish sound system and lighting. Our parish was built in 1957 and some of the items are way overdue for upgrades as the church is almost 70 years old. The parking lot has been cited by the Archdiocese as a potential safety hazard.

The second campaign is a loan repayment initiative. As presented in the 2021 financial statements there are outstanding loans payable to the Archdiocese of \$581,000. The Archdiocese has graciously allowed a matching program for our loan repayment campaign and a dollar for dollar match up to \$200,000. That means if we raise \$200,000, the Archdiocese will match that \$200,000 for a total repayment of \$400,000.

The proceeds of these two campaigns will go directly to supporting St. Dominic's. With the Family of Faith campaign that was started in 2015, only 25% of the amounts went towards St. Dominic's and the remainder went to the Archdiocese. We are hoping parishioners would contribute to these campaigns in the same capacity as they donated to the Family of Faith campaign.

Working together we can make these two campaigns a success.


