Second Sunday in Ordinary Time REFLECTIONS



Readings 1Samuel 3.3b-10,19 1Corinthians 6.13-15a, 17-20

John 1.35-42

The First reading from the first Book of Samuel was explicit in the presentation of the voice of God calling on Samuel to serve in the Temple. It is the same voice that is inviting all Christians in our contemporary world. The initial confusion experienced by the young Samuel is even more evident in our world of confused values. There are so many voices around us. There are so many realities calling our attention simultaneously. Besides, modern relativism of our world has killed the idea of objective truth. It took the guidance of the priest Eli to enabled Samuel discern and respond to God's call. This is similar to the presentation of the true Lamb of God by John the Baptist to his disciples.

At baptism, we were all called into having personal experience of God. A personal experience of God strengthens our Christian living; Christianity is above Church attendance, though Church attendance cannot be separated from Christianity. We need the Church; we need one another. Samuel needed Eli, while the two disciples of John needed John.

God reveals himself and speaks to us in the ordinary events of life, good or bad. There may be things in our lives that hinder our hearing or understanding the voice of God. There are so many deceptive voices calling today, trying to confuse the children of God. We must be careful about the voice we listen to, about the voice we follow. Do not let yourself be deceived by the end-times agents of the devil; watch and pray. As we celebrate this Sunday, let us open up to the promptings of the Holy Spirit working in and through the Church and the ordinary events of our lives.

Jan 13th – Jan 20th, 2024 NEW FUNDING CAMPAIGNS

Since the spring, we have raised \$44,000 for the loan repayment and we have pledges of another \$25,000 to be collected for a total of \$69,000. Our goal for the loan repayment campaign was \$200,000 since the Archdiocese has graciously allowed a matching program for our loan repayment campaign up to \$200,000. This means we are currently at 35% of our goal.



Secondly, we have raised \$31,000 for the capital campaign and have pledges of \$22,000 to be collected for a total of \$51,000 that has been raised so far. Our goal was to try to generate \$100,000 as we estimate that the resurfacing of the parking lot will cost \$150,000 and we have already previously raised \$50,000 through the family of faith campaign. That means we are at 51% of our goal, and again, this encouraging result deserves some congratulations.

We would like to thank those ministries and various parishioners who have been organizing events in support of these two concurrent campaigns. The creativity and support have been tremendous and speak to how dedicated our parishioners are to St. Dominic parish!

Once again, thank you for your amazing generosity which has started both campaigns on a great path. Working together we can continue to make these two campaigns a success.


