First Sunday of Lent



REFLECTIONS

Readings Genesis 9:8-15 1 Peter 3:18-22 Mark 1:12-15

Forty days in the wilderness was not easy, but Jesus conquered them all as a true man. Jesus proclaimed: "This is the time of fulfillment. The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." This message should be heard everywhere and at any time. Lenten season is about two things: repentance and baptism. On the First Sunday of Lent, the Church will celebrate the rite of election for catechumens who are preparing for Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. I would like to remind all of you that the message of repentance is not only for catechumens, but also for all of us. If we want to be in God's Kingdom, we need to repent, to be baptized and to believe.

Dear friends in Christ, the Lenten season always reminds us that we need to get rid of our heart whatever hurting our relationship with God and with people around us. We have to step out of our comfort zone to reach out to God, and reach out to our brothers and sisters in need. Jesus spent forty days alone in the wilderness before he began his public ministry was necessary.

I hope all of us can be alone with God sometimes during this lent. I believe: only in a quiet place, we can face ourselves. Only in a quiet place, we can hear God's voice. Saint Peter said some truth about our baptism today. He said: "This prefigured baptism, which saves you now. It is not a removal of dirt from the body, but an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ." Remember: when we let go of our selfish ego, our sinful habits and our sinful relationship, we are letting God take control of our life again. This is the time to repent and believe in the gospel.

Lent is a time to fast from certain things and to feast on others. It is a season when we:

Fast from judging others; feast on the Christ dwelling in them. Fast from emphasis on differences; feast on the unity of all life. Fast from thoughts of illness; feast on the healing power of God. (Living with Christ)

Feb 17th – Feb 24th, 2024 NEW FUNDING CAMPAIGNS

Since the spring, we have raised \$48,000 for the loan repayment and we have pledges of another \$25,000 to be collected for a total of \$69,000. Our goal for the loan repayment campaign was \$200,000 since the Archdiocese has graciously allowed a matching program for our loan repayment campaign up to \$200,000. This means we are currently at 35% of our goal.



Secondly, we have raised \$36,000 for the capital campaign and have pledges of \$15,000 to be collected for a total of \$51,000 that has been raised so far. Our goal was to try to generate \$100,000 as we estimate that the resurfacing of the parking lot will cost \$150,000 and we have already previously raised \$50,000 through the family of faith campaign. That means we are at 51% of our goal, and again, this encouraging result deserves some congratulations.

We would like to thank those ministries and various parishioners who have been organizing events in support of these two concurrent campaigns. The creativity and support have been tremendous and speak to how dedicated our parishioners are to St. Dominic parish!

For those of us who would like to make a one-time donation, envelopes for the two campaigns are available at the entrances of the church and we have the ability to take online donations for each of the campaigns if you visit the St. Dominic's website (https://stdominicsmi.archtoronto.org).

Once again, thank you for your amazing generosity which has started both campaigns on a great path. Working together we can continue to make these two campaigns a success.


