

Easter Sunday REFLECTIONS



Readings Acts 10:34a, 37-43 Colossians 3:1-4 John 20:1-9

The stone across the tomb symbolized the end of the road; for them, Jesus has been locked in, no way out. But the God who makes a way where there seems to be no way made a way, the resurrection power rolled the stone away, and Jesus rose triumphantly. That is what the resurrection power does to every



believer; it moves the stone away. Like Mary Magdalene, we may be wondering who would roll the stone away for us; the rock of depression, the stone of sickness, the stone of fear, and whatever kind of stone, the devil, may have blocked our way with. The resurrection power of Jesus Christ can roll every stone away.

The resurrection of Jesus is victory over lies and darkness; it is victory over sickness, over every wickedness of the devil. The Angel rolled the stone away and sat on it, which shows that the battle is over and victory is the Lord's. As we celebrate this victory, let us continue to live in the light of the resurrection power of Jesus Christ. That is what Paul makes us understand in our second reading this morning, that if we have been raised with Christ, then we should live the life of the resurrection.

Living the life of the resurrection is to continuously look up to the things of heaven while still leaving here on; it is to be conscious that this world is not our home; we are only passing through. Our lives here on earth should bear witness to the resurrection and be bold enough like Peter to testify that Jesus is alive. Peter testified that they ate and drank with Him after He rose from the dead, He is indeed alive. We are all called today to be true witnesses to the resurrection, not just to testify that we ate and drank with Him, but that we continue to eat and drink with Him in the Eucharist. Jesus is alive; He will never die again. Let us, therefore, hold onto the resurrection power and ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen us never to give up.'

Mar 30th – Apr 6th, 2024 NEW FUNDING CAMPAIGNS

Since the spring, we have raised \$48,000 for the loan repayment and we have pledges of another \$25,000 to be collected for a total of \$69,000. Our goal for the loan repayment campaign was \$200,000 since the Archdiocese has graciously allowed a matching program for our loan repayment campaign up to \$200,000. This means we are currently at 35% of our goal.



Secondly, we have raised \$36,000 for the capital campaign and have pledges of \$15,000 to be collected for a total of \$51,000 that has been raised so far. Our goal was to try to generate \$100,000 as we estimate that the resurfacing of the parking lot will cost \$150,000 and we have already previously raised \$50,000 through the family of faith campaign. That means we are at 51% of our goal, and again, this encouraging result deserves some congratulations.

We would like to thank those ministries and various parishioners who have been organizing events in support of these two concurrent campaigns. The creativity and support have been tremendous and speak to how dedicated our parishioners are to St. Dominic parish!

Once again, thank you for your amazing generosity which has started both campaigns on a great path. Working together we can continue to make these two campaigns a success.
