Readings: Isaiah 6:1-9a, 3-8 1Cor 15:1-11 Lk 5:1-11

Many times we hear people when they are challenged to serve the Church, their immediate reactions are: 'I am not suitable to become or to serve the Church.' 'I am busy now or I have so much work to attend to.' But who among us is suitable to serve in the Church then? – Nobody! It is because all of us could be found unsuitable in many ways.

In today's three readings, Isaiah, one of the greatest prophets in the Old Testament, Peter and Paul, two of the greatest apostles of Jesus in the New Testament, also express their deep inner sense of being unworthy or unsuitable to serve the Lord. They all have the same conviction, which is shared by all who meet the Lord.

If Isaiah, Paul, and Peter are not worthy to serve the Lord, how much less worthy are we! Their responses are our responses too; that is to serve and to take on the journey of conversion. That is to accept the invitation or even the challenge that God has placed in front of us. Jesus says to St. Peter, "Don't be afraid" so that these few words are assuring Peter with his ongoing blessings on his chosen disciple. We are also chosen people of God in our own capacities, and we are encouraged to leave behind things and follow the Lord according to our circumstances.

Let us use this Sunday as a time to look deeper into our lives as Peter throughout the net into deeper water. That will be where God will enlighten us to find a way in assisting one another in seeking and understanding God.

We have two ongoing campaigns – the loan repayment campaign and the capital campaign primarily to repave the parking lot.

As of November 2024, we have raised \$93,000 for the loan repayment campaign. Our goal for the loan repayment campaign was \$200,000 since the Archdiocese has graciously allowed a matching program for our loan repayment campaign up to \$200,000. This means we are currently at 47% of our goal. With the additional matching from the Archdiocese, we have been able to repay \$186,000 of the debt owed to the Archdiocese since the campaign began.

Our loan to the Archdiocese has been significantly reduced from \$600,000 at the end of 2022 to \$454,000 at the end of 2023, and down to \$368,000 at the end of November. This is significant progress, and is something we should be proud of as a parish.

Also, at the end of November 2024, we have raised \$77,000 for the capital campaign. The Parish had previously raised \$56,000 from the Family of Faith campaign for a total of \$133,000. Our goal was to try to generate \$150,000 for the resurfacing of the parking lot. That means we are at 89% of our goal through all of the generous gifts and events which have been organized by parishioners. We were able to generate the additional \$30,000 that we discussed in June so we can start the parking lot repaying project this spring.

We would like to again thank the many ministries and various parishioners who have been organizing events in support of these two concurrent campaigns through bake sales, dinner/dances, BBQs, rose sales, and many other social events. The creativity and support have been tremendous and speak to how dedicated our parishioners are to St. Dominic's parish!

We hope this update further encourages everyone to continue the great momentum - for those of us who would like to make a one-time donation, envelopes for the two campaigns are available at the entrances of the church and we have the ability to take online donations for each of the campaigns if you visit the St. Dominic's website (<u>https://stdominicsmi.archtoronto.org</u>). Those little cards that are in the pews and at the back of the church have a QR code which will take you right to the website to set up a donation. **Working together we can continue to make these two campaigns a success.**
