#### **REFLECTIONS**



Readings: Joshua: 5:9a,10-12 2 Corinthians: 5:17-21 Luke: 15:1-3, 11-32

Today on Laetare Sunday, we are encouraged and uplifted by the Parable of the Prodigal Son First, notice the context. Jesus was receiving criticism from the Pharisees for including tax collectors and sinners into his circle. "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." Rather than rebuff the Pharisees directly, he engages them in one of his most iconic parables.

Notice the wayward son. He has sunk so low in his journey away from home that he seriously considers eating the feed that is given to swine. He "comes to his senses" with the realization of his father's love and decides to return home, rehearsing a formal apology speech: "Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I no longer deserve to be called your son."

you. I no longer deserve to be called your son."

Notice the father. "While he [the son] was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him, and was filled with compassion. He ran to his son, embraced him and kissed him." And when the son tries to deliver his rehearsed speech, the father does not need to hear it because he already knows his son's heart. Instead, he orders his servants to prepare a great banquet. "Let us celebrate with a feast, because this son of mine was dead and has come back to life again; he was lost and has been found." Notice the jealous brother. People often speak of him disparagingly, but that's missing the point: God's love is bigger than our jealousies and personality dynamics. God embraces ALL: saints and sinners! That's Good News! All this is from God, who has reconciled us to himself through Jesus Christ and given us the ministry of reconciliation, namely, God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ.

We rejoice because of God's abundant mercy. The temptation to sin can be overwhelming and impossible as it nudges us away from God. But once we "come to our senses" and seek forgiveness, the Lord is ready to embrace us and welcome us home. God calls us to reconciliation. Let us rejoice, indeed!

#### **NEW FUNDING CAMPAIGNS**

We have two ongoing campaigns – the loan repayment campaign and the capital campaign primarily to repaye the parking lot.

As of November 2024, we have raised \$93,000 for the loan repayment campaign. Our goal for the loan repayment campaign was \$200,000 since the Archdiocese has graciously allowed a matching program for our loan repayment campaign up to \$200,000. This means we are currently at 47% of our goal. With the additional matching from the Archdiocese, we have been able to repay \$186,000 of the debt owed to the Archdiocese since the campaign began.

Our loan to the Archdiocese has been significantly reduced from \$600,000 at the end of 2022 to \$454,000 at the end of 2023, and down to \$368,000 at the end of November. This is significant progress, and is something we should be proud of as a parish.

Also, at the end of November 2024, we have raised \$77,000 for the capital campaign. The Parish had previously raised \$56,000 from the Family of Faith campaign for a total of \$133,000. Our goal was to try to generate \$150,000 for the resurfacing of the parking lot. That means we are at 89% of our goal through all of the generous gifts and events which have been organized by parishioners.

We were able to generate the additional \$30,000 that we discussed in June so we can start the parking lot repaying project this spring.

We would like to again thank the many ministries and various parishioners who have been organizing events in support of these two concurrent campaigns through bake sales, dinner/dances, BBQs, rose sales, and many other social events. The creativity and support have been tremendous and speak to how dedicated our parishioners are to St. Dominic's parish!

We hope this update further encourages everyone to continue the great momentum for those of us who would like to make a one-time donation, envelopes for the two campaigns are available at the entrances of the church and we have the ability to take online donations for each of the campaigns if you visit the St. Dominic's website (<a href="https://stdominicsmi.archtoronto.org">https://stdominicsmi.archtoronto.org</a>). Those little cards that are in the pews and at the back of the church have a QR code which will take you right to the website to set up a donation. Working together we can continue to make these two campaigns a success.
