Pastor's Corner

Readings: Zephaniah 2:3; 3:12-13 | Corinthians 1:26-31 | Matthew 5:1-12a

The Beatitudes—a word meaning “blessings”—are indeed the key to world peace, the key to personal happiness, and the key to that holiness needed to enter one day into the Kingdom of Heaven. The reason is simple: these teachings of Christ reject the false, selfish, and self-destructive values of this world, and instead invite us to begin living here and now according to the rhythms and values of Heaven. We cannot do this on our own, of course, but God's grace is readily offered and given to everyone seeking to live as a true disciple of Jesus, most especially by means of prayer, Sacred Scripture, and the Sacraments. Those who claim living by the Beatitudes is impossible, unrealistic, or too other-worldly are probably either afraid, lacking in faith, or too caught up in the things of this world. However, the way of life Jesus proposes today is achievable, with His help, and the only guaranteed way of finding and preserving true and lasting happiness and peace. We might say the Beatitudes are a way of leveraging the 40% of life we can control into a 100% chance of success in finding a true purpose in our time on earth and in preparing ourselves for a holy and joyous eternity.

Life is often hard or painful, and we can easily find reasons for discouragement, disappointment, and sometimes even despair—as far too many people in today's world have discovered. However, this was not God's plan, and it doesn't have to be that way. Jesus offers us a very different way of living, and throughout the Church's history millions of Catholics and other Christians—including great saints and ordinary believers—have discovered that it really works. May this also be true for each one of us—for in this way the Gospel will be unleashed, our lives will be sanctified, and our world will be transformed.



NEW FUNDING CAMPAIGNS

We like to thank the parish for patiently waiting for an update on our campaigns especially the capital campaign for our parking lot resurfacing. There was a lot of work behind the scenes. We had to get approval from the Archdiocese for several steps through the project. The Archdiocese insisted we hire an engineering firm for overseeing the project to make ensure the quality of work being performed. We had to go through a vendor selection process for an engineering firm. Once they were selected and approved the engineering firm had to approve the scope of the project and a budget and go through another vendor selection process for the company to do the paving. The engineering firm recommended that additional masonry work had to be done so that the parking lot asphalt didn't touch the brick of the building which would lead to deterioration of the building brickwork.

The contractor selected to do the paving quoted \$229,000. The masonry work was \$45,000 and the engineering firm was \$15,000 for a total cost of \$289,000. We have raised \$133,000 for the capital campaign. The Parish had previously raised \$56,000 from the Family of Faith campaign for a total of \$189,000. This means that we will have to borrow an additional \$100,000 from the Archdiocese to fund the project.

For the loan repayment we have raised \$127,000 of the \$200,000 goal or 63% of our goal. That means we can raise another \$73,000 that will be matched by the Archdiocese. The focus on the upcoming year is to repay the loan and take advantage of the matching program.



The creativity and support have been tremendous and speak to how dedicated our parishioners are to St. Dominic's parish!

We hope this update further encourages everyone to continue the great momentum - for those of us who would like to make a one-time donation, envelopes for the two campaigns are available at the entrances of the church as well as the donation boxes. 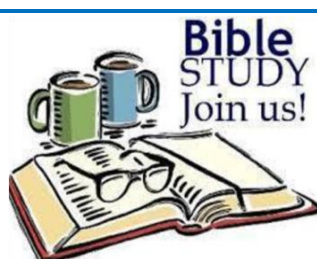

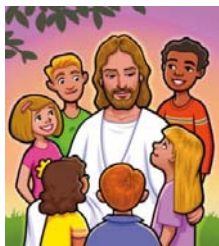

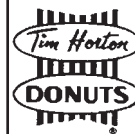
